2021 was a record fiscal year for St. Jude's Ranch for Children. In our 55th year of service to the Southern Nevada community, we reached a new milestone, serving more children and young people than ever before. We served 643 clients across all our programs which is a 13% increase from the prior year. All of the children and young people we have served are extraordinary individuals with hopes and dreams. Despite coming to us as victims of abuse, neglect, exploitation, and homelessness, broken-hearted, and feeling so alone in the world, we provided hope and healing. That's a testament to the commitment and compassion of our partner agencies, our financial supporters, our volunteers, and our staff. It has not been an easy year. We've had to adjust our processes and make hard decisions. We've asked more from our supporters than ever. But the result of all that effort is undeniable.

MEET VANESSA

Vanessa is former client of our homeless youth program. With access to housing services for several years, she was able to focus on school. After her acceptance to Dixie State University, she received a scholarship through the St. Jude's Ranch Scholarship Program, which paid for housing and tuition.

She recently graduated with a Bachelor's
Degree in Criminal Justice and an Associate's
Degree in Early Childhood Education.
Vanessa is now using her life experiences to
help children with trauma and challenging
experiences.



A family disagreement once led Deja down a path to homelessness. But with help from St. Jude's Ranch, she was able to change the course with housing support services. In three years, Deja crossed off both personal and educational goals: found a job, got a high school diploma with a 3.9 GPA and received a CNA certification.





PROJECT SUMMARY

Leveraging a 55-year history of providing residential care to children and young people that have experienced complex trauma, St. Jude's Ranch for Children will create the Healing Center. It's the first of its kind program for the specialized care for child victims of sex trafficking.

The Healing Center will offer trauma specific treatment to victims with a goal to have them move along the continuum of healing, from victims to survivors, and then thriving in our community.
