

Nicole's drive allowed her to pay for her own rent, she stayed focused and was able to graduate to our Rapid Re-housing program where she moved into her own apartment in the community. She was then recommended for a job training program that recently welcomed her as a paid staff member of St. Jude's Ranch for Children's as a receptionist. Thanks to the resources and support once offered to her, Nicole has a desire to one day be a case manager and is working toward that goal. We are proud of you Nicole! Being from a rural part of Nevada meant that Aria and her family would have to travel greater lengths to spend time together at Camp to Belong 2022. 



PROJECTSummary

St. Jude's Ranch for Children, a community of healing and hope, is building on its 56-year legacy. With the help of our construction team—Grand Canyon Development Partners, EV&A Architects, Taney Engineering, and The Whiting-Turner Contracting Company—we will build a campus for children who are victims of sex trafficking that is unlike any other nationwide with safe therapeutic homes and a

specialized nurturing recovery program. The campus will sit on 10 acres of land with a series of individual therapeutic homes to help a growing victim population that has nowhere else to turn for holistic treatment and housing options. The first of its kind in the country, the Healing Center will address every facet of the recovery process, while providing a safe space in which survivors can heal, while still participating in fundamental parts of childhood, including going to school and creating happy, positive experiences. Construction is expected to be completed by Spring of 2024 and the center is expected to be open for residents by Summer 2024.
